AMENDMENT TO H.R. 503, AS REPORTED**OFFERED BY Mr. Goodlatte**

In the paragraph (8) of section 5 of the Horse Protection Act, which is being added by subsection (c)(2) of section 1 of the bill, strike "consumption." and insert the following: "consumption, except that this prohibition shall not take effect until 30 days after the date on which the Secretary of Agriculture (A) determines that, based on empirical evidence, the prohibition is supported by a majority of those persons who have been owners of a horse or other equine in the United States during a representative period, as determined by the Secretary, and (B) notifies Congress of that determination."
