**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 3021, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. PRICE OF GEORGIA**

Page 7, line 3, strike paragraph (3) and insert the following paragraph:

1 (3) GRANTS TO LOCAL EDUCATIONAL AGEN-
2 CIES.—

3 (A) IN GENERAL.—From the amount allo-
4 cated to a State under paragraph (1), each eli-
5 gible local educational agency in the State shall
6 receive an amount in proportion to the amount
7 received by such local educational agency under
8 part A of title I of the Elementary and Sec-
9 ondary Education Act of 1965 for the previous
10 fiscal year relative to the total amount received
11 by all local educational agencies in the State
12 under such part for such fiscal year, except that
13 no local educational agency that received funds
14 under title I of that Act for such fiscal year
15 shall receive a grant of less than \$5,000 in any
16 fiscal year under this title.

17 (B) ELIGIBLE LOCAL EDUCATIONAL AGEN-
18 CY.—For purposes of subparagraph (A), the

1 term “eligible local educational agency” means
2 a local educational agency that—

3 (i) meets the requirements of section
4 1112(a) of the Elementary and Secondary
5 Education Act of 1965; and

6 (ii) conducts an independent audit by
7 a third-party entity, and is certified by the
8 State, substantiating the overall condition
9 of the public school facilities and the need
10 for modernization, renovation, or repair.
