Page 10, strike lines 1 through 8 and insert the following:

1 “(D) address issues of environmental jus-
2 tice, including policies and methods for elimi-
3 nating disparate enforcement of environmental
4 laws and regulations, including with respect to
5 low-income communities.

Page 10, strike lines 9 through 11 and insert the following:

6 “(3) Developing and implementing new policy
7 approaches to environmental education, which shall
8 include a discussion of—
9 “(A) the benefits and costs to the environ-
10 ment and to consumers regarding increasing
11 the supply of energy produced in the United
12 States from—
13 “(i) oil and gas drilling;
14 “(ii) nuclear power;
15 “(iii) new coal technologies; and

1 “(iv) clean renewable and alternative
2 sources of energy, including wind, solar,
3 geothermal, hydropower, and advanced
4 biofuels; and

5 “(B) the best strategies for reducing en-
6 ergy consumption through an enhanced em-
7 phasis on efficiency and conservation.
