**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5876, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. PRICE OF GEORGIA**

Page 29, strike lines 16 through 20 and insert the following:

1 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPORPRIATIONS; CERTAIN
2 PROHIBITIONS.—

3 (1) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—

4 Section 112(a)(1) of the Child Abuse Prevention and
5 Treatment Act (42 U.S.C. 5106h(a)(1)) is amended
6 by inserting before the period at the end the fol-
7 lowing: “, and \$198,000,000 for each of fiscal years
8 2009 through 2013”.

9 (2) PROHIBITION ON EARMARKS.—None of the
10 funds appropriated pursuant to the amendment
11 made by paragraph (1) may be obligated or ex-
12 pended for a Congressional earmark as defined in
13 clause 9(d) of rule XXI of the Rules of the House
14 of Representatives.

15 (3) PROHIBITION ON ABUSIVE COVERED PRO-
16 GRAMS.—None of the funds appropriated pursuant
17 to the amendment made by paragraph (1) may be
18 provided to a covered program that is determined to

1 be in violation of the standards required under sec-
2 tion 3(a)(1) of this Act.
