RESOLUTION

Waiving a requirement of clause 6(a) of rule XIII with respect to consideration of certain resolutions reported from the Committee on Rules.

Resolved, That the requirement of clause 6(a) of rule XIII for a two-thirds vote to consider a report from the Committee on Rules on the same day it is presented to the House is waived with respect to any resolution reported through the legislative day of December 13, 2008, providing for consideration or disposition of a measure relating to financial assistance to eligible automobile manufacturers, and for other purposes.

SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF THE RESOLUTION

The resolution waives clause 6(a) of rule XIII (requiring a two-thirds vote to consider
a rule on the same day it is reported from the Rules Committee) against certain resolutions
reported from the Rules Committee. The rule applies the waiver to any resolution reported
through the legislative day of December 13, 2008 relating to consideration or disposition of a
measure to authorize financial assistance to eligible automobile manufacturers, and for other
