Strike section 1405 (relating to excise tax on medical device manufacturers) and insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. 1405. RESCISSION OF UNOBLIGATED FUNDS FROM**
2 **AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT**
3 **ACT.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Of the unobligated balance of the
5 discretionary appropriations made available by division A
6 of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009
7 (Public Law 111-5) as of the date of the enactment of
8 this Act, there is rescinded the amount determined by the
9 Director of the Office of Management and Budget to be
10 equal to \$20 billion over 10 years.

11 (b) **APPLICATION.**—The rescission made by sub-
12 section (a) shall be applied proportionately—

13 (1) to each discretionary account; and

14 (2) within each such account, to each program,
15 project, and activity (with programs, projects, and
16 activities as delineated in the appropriation Act or
17 accompanying reports for the relevant fiscal year

1 covering such account, or for accounts not included
2 in appropriation Act, as delineated in the most re-
3 cently submitted President's budget).

4 (c) REPEAL OF SECTION 9009 OF THE PATIENT
5 PROTECTION AND AFFORDABLE HEALTH CARE ACT.—
6 Section 9009 of the Patient Protection and Affordable
7 Care Act, as amended by section 10904 of such Act, is
8 repealed effective as of the date of enactment of that Act.
