Page 26, after line 2, insert the following (and re-designate succeeding subsections accordingly):

- 1 (c) NATIONAL GANG INTELLIGENCE CENTER.—
- 2 (1) ESTABLISHMENT.—The Attorney General
- 3 shall establish a National Gang Intelligence Center
- 4 to be housed at and administered by the Federal
- 5 Bureau of Investigation to collect, analyze, and dis-
- 6 seminate gang activity information from—
- 7 (A) the Federal Bureau of Investigation;
- 8 (B) the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Fire-
- 9 arms, and Explosives;
- 10 (C) the Drug Enforcement Administration;
- 11 (D) the Bureau of Prisons;
- 12 (E) the United States Marshals Service;
- 13 (F) the Directorate of Border and Trans-
- 14 portation Security of the Department of Home-
- 15 land Security;
- 16 (G) the Department of Housing and Urban
- 17 Development;
- 18 (H) State and local law enforcement;
- 19 (I) Federal, State, and local prosecutors;



1 (J) Federal, State, and local probation and
2 parole offices; and

3 (K) Federal, State, and local prisons and
4 jails.

5 (2) INFORMATION.—The Center established
6 under paragraph (1) shall make available the infor-
7 mation referred to in paragraph (1) to—

8 (A) Federal, State, and local law enforce-
9 ment agencies;

10 (B) Federal, State, and local corrections
11 agencies and penal institutions; and

12 (C) Federal, State, and local prosecutorial
13 agencies.

14 (3) ANNUAL REPORT.—The Center established
15 under paragraph (1) shall annually submit to Con-
16 gress a report on gang activity.
