**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1279, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. GOODLATTE OF VIRGINIA**

Page 22, after line 3, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 116. CRIMES OF VIOLENCE AND DRUG CRIMES COM-**
2 **MITTED BY ILLEGAL ALIENS.**

3 (a) OFFENSES.—Title 18, United States Code, is
4 amended by inserting after chapter 51 the following new
5 chapter:

6 **“CHAPTER 52—ILLEGAL ALIENS**

“Sec.

“1131. Enhanced penalties for certain crimes committed by illegal aliens.

7 **“§ 1131. Enhanced penalties for certain crimes com-**
8 **mitted by illegal aliens**

9 “Whoever, being an alien who is unlawfully present
10 in the United States, commits, conspires or attempts to
11 commit, a crime of violence (as defined in section 16) or
12 a drug trafficking offense (as defined in section 924), shall
13 be fined under this title and sentenced to not less than
14 5 years in prison. If the defendant was previously ordered
15 removed under the Immigration and Nationality Act on
16 the grounds of having committed a crime, the defendant
17 shall be sentenced to not less than 15 years in prison .
18 A sentence of imprisonment imposed under this section



1 shall run consecutively to any other sentence of imprison-
2 ment imposed for any other crime.”.

3 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of chapters
4 at the beginning of part I of title 18, United States Code,
5 is amended by inserting after the item relating to chapter
6 51 the following new item:

“52. Illegal aliens 1131”.

7 **SEC. 117. LISTING OF IMMIGRATION VIOLATORS IN THE NA-**
8 **TIONAL CRIME INFORMATION CENTER DATA-**
9 **BASE.**

10 (a) PROVISION OF INFORMATION TO THE NCIC.—
11 Not later than 180 days after the date of enactment of
12 this Act, the Under Secretary for Border and Transpor-
13 tation Security of the Department of Homeland Security
14 shall provide the National Crime Information Center of
15 the Department of Justice with such information as the
16 Director may have on any and all aliens against whom
17 a final order of removal has been issued, and any and all
18 aliens who have signed a voluntary departure agreement.
19 Such information shall be provided to the National Crime
20 Information Center regardless of whether or not the alien
21 received notice of a final order of removal and even if the
22 alien has already been removed.

23 (b) INCLUSION OF INFORMATION IN THE NCIC
24 DATABASE.—Section 534(a) of title 28, United States
25 Code, is amended—



1 (1) in paragraph (3), by striking “and” at the
2 end;

3 (2) by redesignating paragraph (4) as para-
4 graph (5); and

5 (3) by inserting after paragraph (3) the fol-
6 lowing:

7 “(4) acquire, collect, classify, and preserve
8 records of violations of the immigration laws of the
9 United States, regardless of whether or not the alien
10 has received notice of the violation and even if the
11 alien has already been removed; and”.
