**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2601, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. KENNEDY OF MINNESOTA**

Page 201, after line 10, insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. 907. REQUIREMENTS RELATING TO THE LARGEST EX-**
2 **PORTING AND IMPORTING COUNTRIES OF**
3 **CERTAIN PRECURSOR CHEMICALS.**

4 (a) **REPORTING REQUIREMENTS.**—Section 489(a) of
5 the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 (22 U.S.C. 2291h(a)),
6 as amended by sections 317(d) and 906 of this Act, is
7 further amended by adding at the end the following new
8 paragraph:

9 “(10)(A) A separate section that contains the
10 following:

11 “(i) An identification of the five countries
12 that exported the largest amount of
13 pseudoephedrine, ephedrine, and phenyl-
14 propanolamine during the preceding calendar
15 year.

16 “(ii) An identification of the five countries
17 that imported the largest amount of precursor
18 chemicals described in clause (i) during the pre-
19 ceding calendar year and have the highest rate



1 of diversion of such precursor chemicals for use
2 in the illicit production of methamphetamine.

3 “(iii) An economic analysis of the total
4 worldwide production of the precursor chemicals
5 described in clause (i) as compared to the legiti-
6 mate demand for such precursor chemicals
7 worldwide.

8 “(B) The identification of countries that im-
9 ported the largest amount of precursor chemicals
10 under subparagraph (A)(ii) shall be based on the fol-
11 lowing:

12 “(i) An economic analysis that estimates
13 the legitimate demand for such precursor
14 chemicals in such countries as compared to the
15 actual or estimated amount of such chemicals
16 that is imported into such countries.

17 “(ii) The best available data and other in-
18 formation regarding the production of meth-
19 amphetamine in such countries and the diver-
20 sion of such precursor chemicals for use in the
21 production of methamphetamine.”.

22 (b) ANNUAL CERTIFICATION PROCEDURES.—Section
23 490(a) of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 (22 U.S.C.
24 2291j(a)) is amended—



1 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “major illicit
2 drug producing country or major drug-transit coun-
3 try” and inserting “major illicit drug producing
4 country, major drug-transit country, or country
5 identified under clause (i) or (ii) of section
6 489(a)(10)(A) of this Act”; and

7 (2) in paragraph (2), by inserting after “(as de-
8 termined under subsection (h))” the following: “or
9 country identified under clause (i) or (ii) of section
10 489(a)(10)(A) of this Act”.
