**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2745, AS REPORTED  
OFFERED BY MR. BARTON OF TEXAS**

In section 104(a), add at the end the following new paragraph:

1           (7)(A) The IOB shall review the Final Report  
2 of the Independent Inquiry Committee (IIC) into the  
3 United Nations Oil for Food Program (OFF). The  
4 IOB's review should focus on the adequacy of the  
5 IIC's Final Report or any subsequent reports of the  
6 IIC or of any possible successor to the IIC. The  
7 IOB's review of the IIC's Final Report should ad-  
8 dress the Final Report's treatment of and adequacy  
9 in the following areas:

10           (i) OFF's operations from inception  
11 through the transfer of power from the Coali-  
12 tion Provisional Authority to the interim Iraqi  
13 government;

14           (ii) claims of oil smuggling, illegal sur-  
15 charges on oil and commissions on commodity  
16 contracts, illegal kick-backs, use of oil alloca-  
17 tions to influence foreign government officials  
18 and international people of influence, and use of  
19 funds for military purposes;



1 (iii) the involvement, directly or indirectly,  
2 of any entity, bureau, division, department, spe-  
3 cialized agency, or employee (including the Sec-  
4 retary General) of the United Nations, includ-  
5 ing any employee of the specialized agencies of  
6 the United Nations or any employee or officer  
7 of the Secretariat;

8 (iv) the IIC's findings, discovery and use of  
9 evidence, and investigation practices; and

10 (v) the extent of cooperation by the United  
11 Nations with requests by Congress for testi-  
12 mony, interviews, documents, correspondence,  
13 reports, memoranda, books, papers, accounts,  
14 or records related to the Oil for Food Program.

15 (B) Subsequent to the IOB's review, the IOB  
16 shall determine in a written report whether the IIC  
17 investigation is incomplete or inadequate in any re-  
18 spects and whether any additional investigation is  
19 justified. If the IOB determines that additional in-  
20 vestigation is warranted, it shall appoint, in accord-  
21 ance with paragraph (5), a special investigator and  
22 staff consisting of individuals who are not employees  
23 of the United Nations and to identify specific areas  
24 within the OFF to investigate.
