

1. AN AMENDMENT TO BE OFFERED BY REPRESENTATIVE
FLAKE OF ARIZONA, OR HIS DESIGNEE,
DEBATABLE FOR 10 MINUTES:

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2745, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. FLAKE OF ARIZONA**

At the end of section 104, insert the following new subsection:

1 (f) CERTIFICATION OF UNITED NATIONS COOPERA-
2 TION RELATING TO OIL-FOR-FOOD PROGRAM.—

3 (1) ACTIONS.—In accordance with section 601,
4 a certification shall be required that certifies that
5 the following actions relating to the oil-for-food pro-
6 gram have been taken by the United Nations:

7 (A) The United Nations Secretary General
8 has authorized the release to a law enforcement
9 authority of any Member State (upon request
10 by the permanent representative to the United
11 Nations of such Member State on behalf of
12 such law enforcement authority) or to a na-
13 tional legislative authority authentic copies of
14 any document in the possession of the United
15 Nations, including any document in the posses-
16 sion of a person who was engaged on a contract
17 basis to provide goods or services to the United
18 Nations, that in the judgment of such request-
19 ing law enforcement authority or national legis-



1 lative authority directly or indirectly concerns
2 the oil-for-food program or a sanction imposed
3 on Iraq related to the oil-for-food program.

4 (B) The United Nations has waived any
5 immunity enjoyed by any United Nations offi-
6 cial from the judicial process in the United
7 States for any civil or criminal acts or omis-
8 sions under Federal or State law that may have
9 transpired within the jurisdiction of the United
10 States in connection with the oil-for-food pro-
11 gram.

12 (2) DEFINITION.—As used in this subsection,
13 the term “oil-for-food program” means the program
14 established and administered pursuant to United
15 Nations Security Council Resolution 986 (April 14,
16 1995) and subsequent United Nations resolutions to
17 permit the sale of petroleum products exported from
18 Iraq and to use the revenue generated from such
19 sale for humanitarian assistance.
