AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2745, AS REPORTED

OFFERED BY Mr. KING of New York

In section 104, add at the end the following new subsection:

1 (f) WAIVER OF IMMUNITY.—The President shall di-
2 rect the United States Permanent Representative to the
3 United Nations to use the voice, vote, and influence of the
4 United States at the United Nations to ensure that the
5 Secretary General exercises the right and duty of the Sec-
6 retary General under section 20 of the Convention on the
7 Privileges and Immunities of the United Nations to waive
8 the immunity of any United Nations official in any case
9 in which such immunity would impede the course of jus-
10 tice. In exercising such waiver, the Secretary General is
11 urged to interpret the interests of the United Nations as
12 favoring the investigation or prosecution of a United Na-
13 tions official who is credibly under investigation for having
14 committed a serious criminal offense or who is credibly
15 charged with a serious criminal offense.
