**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2745, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. MCCOTTER OF MICHIGAN**

In section 104(e)(1), add at the end the following new sentence: "The UNOE shall promulgate ethics rules, including the following:".

In section 104(c)(1), add at the end the following new subparagraphs:

1 (A) No employee of any United Nations
2 entity, bureau, division, department, or special-
3 ized agency may be compensated while partici-
4 pating in the domestic politics of the country of
5 such employee, except for voting or acting as
6 part of a Security Council, General Assembly,
7 or legitimately authorized United Nations mis-
8 sion or assignment.

9 (B) No United Nations entity, bureau, di-
10 vision, department, or specialized agency may
11 hire an individual convicted in a generally rec-
12 ognized court of a democratically-elected gov-
13 ernment with an independent judiciary and an
14 extradition treaty with the United States and
15 the European Union for any crime or crimes in-



1 volving financial misfeasance, malfeasance,
2 fraud, or perjury.

3 (C) The employment of an employee of any
4 United Nations entity, bureau, division, depart-
5 ment, or specialized agency who is convicted in
6 a generally recognized court of a democrat-
7 ically-elected government with an independent
8 judiciary and an extradition treaty with the
9 United States and the European Union of any
10 crime or crimes involving financial misfeasance,
11 malfeasance, fraud, or perjury shall be subject
12 to termination.

13 (D) If an employee of any United Nations
14 entity, bureau, division, department, or special-
15 ized agency has contact regarding the disposi-
16 tion of ongoing internal United Nations oper-
17 ations or decisions with an individual who is not
18 an employee or official of the government of a
19 Member State (or a similarly situated indi-
20 vidual), with an individual who is not officially
21 employed by any United Nations entity, bureau,
22 division, department, or specialized agency, or
23 with an individual who is not a working mem-
24 ber of the media, a memorandum of such con-
25 tact shall be prepared by such employee and,

1 upon request, be made available to Member
2 States.
