**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2745, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. PENCE OF INDIANA**

In section 101, add at the end the following new subsections:

1 (e) SCALE OF ASSESSMENTS.—The President shall
2 direct the United States Permanent Representative to the
3 United Nations to use the voice, vote, and influence of the
4 United States at the United Nations to make every effort
5 to ensure that the difference between the scale of assess-
6 ments for the five permanent members of the Security
7 Council is not greater than five times that of any other
8 permanent member of the Security Council.

9 (f) DENIAL OF USE OF VETO.—If the Secretary of
10 State determines that a permanent member of the Secu-
11 rity Council with veto power is not in compliance with the
12 requirement described in subsection (e), the President
13 shall direct the United States Permanent Representative
14 to the United Nations to use the voice, vote, and influence
15 of the United States at the United Nations to make every
16 effort to deny to such permanent member the use of the
17 veto power of such permanent member until such time as
18 such permanent member satisfies the requirement of such
19 subsection.
