**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 3, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. BOOZMAN OF ARKANSAS**

After section 4134, insert the following (and redesignate, and conform the table of contents, of the bill accordingly):

1 SEC. 4132. BREAKS DURING DAILY TOUR OF DUTY.

2 Section 31502 of title 49, United States Code, is
3 amended by adding at the end the following:

4 “(f) BREAKS DURING DAILY TOUR OF DUTY.—Not-
5 withstanding any other provision of law, an operator of
6 a property carrying commercial motor vehicle shall be per-
7 mitted to operate such vehicle and perform other
8 workrelated activities at the end of the 14th hour from
9 the time the driver begins duty, for a period of time for
10 which the driver has been off duty during the 14-hour pe-
11 riod, not to exceed a total of 16 hours.

12 “(g) NO COERCION.—No person shall require or co-
13 erce a motor carrier or its employees to record falsely their
14 duty status as off-duty for any activity defined by the Sec-
15 retary as on-duty.”.
