Add at the end the following:

1 **SEC. ____ . INTERCEPTION OF COMMUNICATIONS.**

2 Section 2516(1) of title 18, United States Code, is
3 amended—

4 (1) in paragraph (e)—

5 (A) by inserting before “section 201 (brib-
6 ery of public officials and witnesses)” the fol-
7 lowing: “section 81 (arson within special mari-
8 time and territorial jurisdiction),”;

9 (B) by inserting before “subsection (d),
10 (e), (f), (g), (h), or (i) of section 844 (unlawful
11 use of explosives)” the following: “subsections
12 (m) or (n) of section 842 (relating to plastic ex-
13 plosives),”; and

14 (C) by inserting before “section 1992 (re-
15 lating to wrecking trains)” the following: “, sec-
16 tion 930(c) (relating to attack on federal facil-
17 ity with firearm), section 956 (conspiracy to
18 harm persons or property overseas),”; and

19 (2) in paragraph (j)—



1 (A) by striking “or” before “section 46502
2 (relating to aircraft piracy)” and inserting a
3 comma after “section 60123(b) (relating to the
4 destruction of a natural gas pipeline”;

5 (B) by inserting “, the second sentence of
6 section 46504 (relating to assault on a flight
7 crew with dangerous weapon), or section
8 46505(b)(3) or (c) (relating to explosive or in-
9 cendiary devices, or endangerment of human
10 life, by means of weapons on aircraft)” before
11 of “title 49”.
