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**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 3402, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MS. SLAUGHTER OF NEW YORK**

Page 104, after line 14, insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. 323. EMERGENCY AUTHORITY OF STATE OR LOCAL**
2 **LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY TO GATHER OR**
3 **RECEIVE EVIDENCE FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT**
4 **PURPOSES OUTSIDE THE TERRITORIAL JU-**
5 **RISDICTION OF THE AGENCY.**

6 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Notwithstanding any other State,
7 local, or tribal law to the contrary, each State, local, or
8 tribal law enforcement agency may, for law enforcement
9 purposes, gather or receive evidence at any place within
10 the United States as the nature of its mission may require,
11 upon a finding by the head of the agency (or, if the head
12 of the agency is unavailable, the person authorized by law
13 to act as head) that, because of emergency conditions, the
14 ability of that agency to carry out its mission, or the abil-
15 ity of victims within the territorial jurisdiction of that
16 agency or of any other such agency to obtain justice, has
17 been substantially impaired.

18 (b) **COORDINATION.**—The Office of Victims of Crime,
19 working in consultation with national, State, and local do-



1 mestic violence, sexual violence, and stalking non-profit,
2 non-governmental organizations, and in collaboration with
3 the Department of Health and Human Services and other
4 appropriate Federal agencies, shall develop and implement
5 a plan under which the Office—

6 (1) coordinates the activities of law enforcement
7 agencies under subsection (a); and

8 (2) coordinates, and provides information and
9 assistance to, victims, service providers, and law en-
10 forcement officials as contemplated by subsection
11 (a).

12 (c) REPORT.—Not later than 90 days after the date
13 of the enactment of this Act, the Office of Victims of
14 Crime shall submit to Congress a report on the plan re-
15 quired by subsection (b).

16 (d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
17 are authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section
18 such sums as may be necessary.
