**AMENDMENT TO 4437**  
**OFFERED BY MR. CASTLE OF DELAWARE**

At the end of title IV, insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. 408. REPORT ON APPREHENSION AND DETENTION OF**  
2 **CERTAIN ALIENS.**

3 (a) **REPORT REQUIRED.**—Not later than two years  
4 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary  
5 of Homeland Security shall submit to Congress a report  
6 on—

7 (1) the number of illegal aliens from noncontig-  
8 uous countries who are apprehended at or between  
9 ports of entry since the date of enactment of this  
10 Act;

11 (2) the number of such aliens who have been  
12 deported since the date of enactment of this Act;  
13 and

14 (3) the number of such aliens from countries  
15 the governments of which the Secretary of State has  
16 determined, for purposes section 6(j)(1)(A) of the  
17 Export Administration Act of 1979 (as in effect pur-  
18 suant to the International Emergency Economic  
19 Powers Act; 50 U.S.C. 1701 et seq.), section 40(d)



1 of the Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C.  
2 2780(d)), section 620A of the Foreign Assistance  
3 Act of 1961 (22 U.S.C. 2371), or other provision of  
4 law, are governments that have repeatedly provided  
5 support for acts of international terrorism.

6 (b) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of Con-  
7 gress that the Secretary of Homeland Security should de-  
8 velop a strategy for entering into appropriate security  
9 screening watch lists the appropriate background informa-  
10 tion of illegal aliens from countries described in paragraph  
11 (3) of subsection (a).
