**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4437, AS REPORTED  
OFFERED BY MR. GINGREY OF GEORGIA**

At the end of title I, insert the following new section:

**1 SEC. 118. SUSPENSION OF VISA WAIVER PROGRAM.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-  
3 sion of law, the visa waiver program established under sec-  
4 tion 217 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.  
5 1187) is hereby suspended until such time as the Secretary  
6 of Homeland Security determines and certifies to Con-  
7 gress that—

8 (1) the automated entry-exit control system au-  
9 thorized under section 110 of the Illegal Immigra-  
10 tion Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act of  
11 1996 (8 U.S.C. 1221 note) is fully implemented and  
12 functional;

13 (2) all United States ports of entry have func-  
14 tional biometric machine readers; and

15 (3) all nonimmigrants, including Border Cross-  
16 ing Card holders, are processed through the auto-  
17 mated entry-exit control system.



1 (b) REPEAL.—Subparagraph (B) of section  
2 217(a)(3) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8  
3 U.S.C. 1187(a)(3)) is hereby repealed.
