

7. AN AMENDMENT TO BE OFFERED BY REPRESENTATIVE
GRAVES OF MISSOURI, OR HIS DESIGNEE,
DEBATABLE FOR 10 MINUTES:

**AMENDMENT TO H. R. 2829, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. GRAVES OF MISSOURI**

At the end of the bill, add the following new section
(and conform the table of contents accordingly):

1 **SEC. 20. REPORT ON GOVERNMENT-SPONSORED METH-**
2 **AMPHETAMINE CONFERENCE.**

3 (a) REPORT.—Not later than 30 days after the date
4 of the enactment of this Act, the Director of the Office
5 of National Drug Control Policy shall submit to Congress
6 a report explaining the rationale and circumstances lead-
7 ing to the sponsorship by the Department of Health and
8 Human Resources, and the participation by employees of
9 such department, in a conference conducted by the Harm
10 Reduction Coalition and the Harm Reduction Project on
11 August 19th and 20th, 2005, in Salt Lake City, Utah,
12 titled the “1st National Conference on Methamphetamine,
13 HIV, and Hepatitis Science & Response”.

14 (b) ADDITIONAL MATTERS COVERED.—The report
15 shall include a description of the management and report-
16 ing systems of the Office of National Drug Control Policy
17 that are in place or that will be put in place to ensure
18 that the policy of the Federal Government is consistently

1 supportive of efforts to prevent the use of methamphet-
2 amine.
