**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2829, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY Ms. HOOLEY OF OREGON**

Page 161, after line 2, insert the following new sub-
section:

1 (n) REQUIREMENT FOR METHAMPHETAMINE STRAT-
2 EGY.—

3 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 90 days after
4 the date of the enactment of this Act, the Director
5 of the Office of National Drug Control Policy shall
6 submit to Congress a comprehensive strategy that
7 addresses the increased threat from methamphet-
8 amine.

9 (2) MATTERS COVERED.—The strategy shall
10 include—

11 (A) interdiction and precursor chemical
12 controls;

13 (B) demand reduction and treatment;

14 (C) alternative development programs;

15 (D) efforts to prevent the diversion of pre-
16 cursor chemicals on an international level; and

17 (E) an assessment of the specific level of
18 funding and resources necessary to significantly

1 to reduce the production and trafficking of
2 methamphetamine.

3 (3) TREATMENT OF CLASSIFIED OR LAW EN-
4 FORCEMENT SENSITIVE INFORMATION.—Any con-
5 tent of the strategy that involves information classi-
6 fied under criteria established by an Executive order,
7 or whose public disclosure, as determined by the Di-
8 rector or the head of any relevant Federal agency,
9 would be detrimental to the law enforcement or na-
10 tional security activities of any Federal, foreign, or
11 international agency, shall be presented to Congress
12 separately from the rest of the strategy.
