Page 161, after line 2, insert the following:

1 (n) MODEL STATE DRUG LAWS.—

2 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Director of the Office of
3 National Drug Control Policy shall provide for a cor-
4 poration that is described in section 501(c)(3) of the
5 Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and exempt from tax
6 under section 501(a) of such Code to—

7 (A) advise States on establishing laws and
8 policies to address alcohol and other drug
9 issues, based on the model State drug laws de-
10 veloped by the President’s Commission on
11 Model State Drug Laws in 1993; and

12 (B) revise such model State drug laws and
13 draft supplementary model State laws to take
14 into consideration changes in the alcohol and
15 drug abuse problems in the State involved.

16 (2) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—
17 There is authorized to be appropriated to carry out
18 this subsection \$1,500,000 for each of fiscal years
19 2007 through 2011.
