**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4200, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. UDALL OF NEW MEXICO**

(page and line numbers refer to the amendment in the nature
of a substitute)

At the end of section 102(e) (page 21, after line 15),
add the following new paragraph:

1 (4) CONSIDERATION OF FIRE RISK AND REGEN-
2 ERATION.—In making any determination under
3 paragraph (1) to implement any pre-approved man-
4 agement practice under section 104 or to develop
5 and carry out a catastrophic event recovery project
6 or catastrophic event research project, or portion of
7 such a project, using emergency procedures under
8 section 105, the Secretary concerned—

9 (A) shall consider the effect of the practice
10 or project on fire risk and forest regeneration;
11 and

12 (B) may not implement the practice or
13 carry out the project unless the Secretary cer-
14 tifies that the practice or project will not in-
15 crease fire-risk or decrease forest regeneration.
