**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5122, AS REPORTED  
OFFERED BY MR. HOSTETTLER OF INDIANA**

At the end of subtitle C of title V (page 126, after line 12), insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. \_\_\_\_ . SPECIAL OPERATIONS FELLOWSHIPS.**

2 (a) FELLOWSHIPS.—The Secretary of Defense shall  
3 prescribe regulations under which the Assistant Secretary  
4 of Defense for Special Operations and Low Intensity Con-  
5 flict may award a fellowship to an eligible person, as de-  
6 scribed in subsection (b), in a discipline determined by the  
7 Assistant Secretary. The authority to award any amount  
8 of funds to any person as a fellowship under this section  
9 is subject to the availability of funds for that purpose.

10 (b) ELIGIBLE PERSON.—A person eligible for a fel-  
11 lowship under this section is a citizen or national of the  
12 United States who is enrolled in or is eligible to enroll  
13 in a program of education leading toward the completion  
14 of a masters degree or a doctoral degree.

15 (c) FELLOWSHIP REQUIREMENTS.—

16 (1) DOCTORAL DEGREE STUDENTS.—The re-  
17 cipient of a fellowship who is a student enrolled in  
18 a program of education leading toward the comple-  
19 tion of a doctoral degree shall agree to prepare a



1       doctoral dissertation in a subject area with military  
2       relevance that is approved by the Assistant Sec-  
3       retary.

4       (2) MASTERS DEGREE STUDENTS.—The recipi-  
5       ent of a fellowship who is a student enrolled in a  
6       program of education leading toward the completion  
7       of a masters degree shall agree to concentrate the  
8       masters degree on a subject area with military rel-  
9       evance that is approved by the Assistant Secretary.

10      (d) REGULATIONS.—The regulations required to be  
11      prescribed under this section shall include each of the fol-  
12      lowing:

13           (1) The criteria for the award of fellowships  
14      under this section.

15           (2) The procedure for selecting recipients of  
16      such fellowships.

17           (3) The basis for determining the amount a fel-  
18      lowship recipient will receive:

19           (4) The total amount that may be used to  
20      award fellowships during an academic year.
