**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5122, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. MICA OF FLORIDA**

At the end of title VI (page 237, after line 8), insert
the following new section:

1 **SEC. 6. SENSE OF CONGRESS CALLING FOR PAYMENT**
2 **TO WORLD WAR II VETERANS WHO SURVIVED**
3 **BATAAN DEATH MARCH.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—It is the sense of Congress that—

5 (1) there should be paid to each living Bataan
6 Death March survivor an amount that is \$4 for each
7 day of captivity during World War II, compounded
8 annually at a 3 percent annual rate of interest; and

9 (2) in the case of a Bataan Death March sur-
10 vivor who is deceased and who has an unremarried
11 surviving spouse, such a payment should be made to
12 that surviving spouse.

13 (b) **BATAAN DEATH MARCH SURVIVOR.**—In this sec-
14 tion, the term “Bataan Death March survivor” means an
15 individual who as a member of the Armed Forces during
16 World War II was captured on the peninsula of Bataan
17 or island of Corregidor in the territory of the Philippines
18 by Japanese forces and participated in and survived the
19 Bataan Death March.
