**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5122, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MS. MILLENDER-MCDONALD OF
CALIFORNIA**

At the end of title X (page 393, after line 23), insert
the following new section:

1 **SEC. ____.** **DETERMINATION OF DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE**
2 **INTRATHEATER AND INTERTHEATER AIRLIFT**
3 **AND SEALIFT MOBILITY REQUIREMENTS.**

4 (a) **DETERMINATION OF REQUIREMENTS.**—The Sec-
5 retary of Defense, as part of the 2006 Mobility Capabili-
6 ties Study, shall determine Department of Defense mobil-
7 ity requirements as follows:

8 (1) The Secretary shall determine intratheater
9 and intertheater airlift mobility requirements and
10 intratheater and intertheater sealift mobility require-
11 ments (all stated in terms of million ton miles per
12 day) for executing each scenario that was modeled in
13 the 2005 Mobility Capabilities Study and each sce-
14 nario that is modeled in the 2006 Mobility Capabili-
15 ties Study.

16 (2) The Secretary shall determine intratheater
17 and intertheater airlift mobility requirements and
18 intratheater and intertheater sealift mobility require-



1 ments (all stated in terms of million ton miles per
2 day) for executing the National Military Strategy
3 with a low acceptable level of risk, with a medium
4 acceptable level of risk, and with a high acceptable
5 level of risk, for each of the following:

6 (A) Major combat operations.

7 (B) The Global War on Terrorism.

8 (C) Baseline security posture operations.

9 (D) Homeland defense and civil support
10 operations.

11 (E) Special operations missions.

12 (F) Global strike missions.

13 (G) Strategic nuclear missions.

14 (b) REPORT.—Not later than February 1, 2007, the
15 Secretary of Defense shall submit to the congressional de-
16 fense committees a report providing the mobility require-
17 ments determined pursuant to subsection (a). The report
18 shall set forth each mobility requirement specified in para-
19 graph (1) or (2) of that subsection.

20 (c) MOBILITY CAPABILITIES STUDIES.—For pur-
21 poses of this section:

22 (1) The term “2006 Mobility Capabilities
23 Study” means the studies conducted by the Sec-
24 retary of Defense and the Joint Staff during 2006



1 as a follow-on to the 2005 Mobility Capabilities
2 Study.

3 (2) The term “2005 Mobility Capabilities
4 Study” means the comprehensive Mobility Capabili-
5 ties Study completed in December 2005 and con-
6 ducted through the Office of Program Analysis and
7 Evaluation of the Department of Defense to assess
8 mobility needs for all aspects of the National De-
9 fense Strategy.
