**AMENDMENT TO 5122, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. WELDON OF PENNSYLVANIA**

At the end of title XII (page 419, after line 7), insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. 12** . SENSE OF CONGRESS CONCERNING COOPERA-
2 TION WITH RUSSIA ON ISSUES PERTAINING
3 TO MISSILE DEFENSE.

4 It is the sense of Congress that—

5 (1) cooperation between the United States and
6 Russia with regard to missile defense is in the inter-
7 est of the United States;

8 (2) there does not exist strong enough engage-
9 ment between the United States and Russia with re-
10 spect to missile defense cooperation;

11 (3) the United States should explore innovative
12 and nontraditional means of cooperation with Russia
13 on issues pertaining to missile defense; and

14 (4) as part of such an effort, the Secretary of
15 Defense should consider the possibilities for United
16 States-Russian cooperation with respect to missile
17 defense through—

18 (A) the testing of specific elements of the
19 detection and tracking equipment of the Missile



1 Defense Agency of the United States Depart-
2 ment of Defense through the use of Russian
3 target missiles; and

4 (B) the provision of early warning radar to
5 the Missile Defense Agency by the use of Rus-
6 sian radar data.
