**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2082, AS REPORTED  
OFFERED BY MR. THOMPSON OF CALIFORNIA**

At the end of subtitle A of title IV (page 39, after line 16), add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 414. REPORT ON PERSONNEL OF THE INTELLIGENCE**  
2 **COMMUNITY.**

3 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Not later than 120 days after the  
4 date of the enactment of this Act, the Director of National  
5 Intelligence shall submit to the congressional intelligence  
6 committees a report containing—

7 (1) the number of intelligence collectors and an-  
8 alysts employed or contracted by each element of the  
9 intelligence community; and

10 (2) a plan to maximize the number of intel-  
11 ligence collectors employed or contracted by the in-  
12 telligence community.

13 (b) **LIMITATION ON PERSONNEL.**—

14 (1) **LIMITATION.**—Subject to paragraph (2),  
15 but notwithstanding any other provision of this Act  
16 (including the classified Schedule of Authorizations  
17 referred to in section 102(a)), the Office of the Di-  
18 rector of National Intelligence is authorized not  
19 more than—

1 (A) the number of personnel employed or  
2 contracted by such Office as of May 9, 2007;  
3 and

4 (B) an additional 15 percent of such num-  
5 ber of personnel employed or contracted by  
6 such Office as of May 9, 2007.

7 (2) TERMINATION OF LIMITATION.—The limita-  
8 tion on the number of personnel authorized for the  
9 Office of the Director of National Intelligence under  
10 paragraph (1) shall no longer apply on or after the  
11 date on which the report required under subsection  
12 (a) is submitted.
