A BILL

To amend the Chesapeake Bay Initiative Act of 1998 to provide for the continuing authorization of the Chesapeake Bay Gateways and Watertrails Network.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Chesapeake Bay Gate-
5 ways and Watertrails Network Continuing Authorization
6 Act”.

7 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

8 Section 502 of the Chesapeake Bay Initiative Act of
9 1998 (16 U.S.C. 461 note; Public Law 105–312) is
10 amending by striking subsection (c) and inserting the fol-
11 lowing:

12 “(c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
13 are authorized to be appropriated such sums as are nec-
14 essary to carry out this section.”.
