**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 3326, AS REPORTED  
OFFERED BY MR. MURTHA OF PENNSYLVANIA  
(Defense Appropriations Bill)**

Page 8, line 11, before the period at the end, insert the following: “: *Provided*, That \$60,199,000 shall be made available for the Joint POW/MIA Accounting Command”.

Page 103, line 3, strike “\$10,000,000” and insert “12,000,000”.

Page 118, after line 15, insert the following new sections:

1        SEC. 8120. None of the funds appropriated or other-  
2 wise made available in this Act may be used for advance  
3 procurement of the F-22 aircraft: *Provided*, That  
4 \$368,800,000 of the funds made available in title III  
5 under the heading “Aircraft Procurement, Air Force” may  
6 be available for the following programs in the following  
7 amounts:

8            (1) \$64,000,000 for production line shut down  
9 activities for the F-22.

10           (2) \$138,800,000 for spare engines for F-22  
11 and C-17 aircraft.

1           (3) \$79,000,000 for LAIRCM kits for the Air  
2       National Guard.

3           (4) \$37,000,000 for advanced targeting pods.

4           (5) \$50,000,000 for advanced radar develop-  
5       ment.

6       SEC. 8121. The amount appropriated in title VI  
7       under the heading "Defense Health Program" for oper-  
8       ation and maintenance is hereby reduced by \$26,000,000  
9       and the amount appropriated under such heading for re-  
10      search, development, test, and evaluation is hereby in-  
11      creased by \$26,000,000.

12      SEC. 8122. None of the funds appropriated or other-  
13      wise made available in this Act may be used to award to  
14      a contractor, or convert to performance by a contractor,  
15      the provision of utilities at the United States Military  
16      Academy at West Point.

17      SEC. 8123. The amounts otherwise provided by this  
18      Act are revised by reducing the amount made available  
19      under title II under the heading "Operation and Mainte-  
20      nance, Air Force", and increasing the amount available  
21      under title VI under the heading "Chemical Agents and  
22      Munitions Destruction, Defense", by \$50,000,000.

23      SEC. 8124. None of the funds appropriated or other-  
24      wise made available in this Act may be used by the Sec-

1 retary of the Army to convert government-owned ammuni-  
2 tion production assets to the private sector.

Page 122, line 3, strike "*Provided, That*" and insert "*Provided, That up to \$241,503,000 of the amount under this heading shall be transferred to the Coast Guard 'Operating Expenses' account: Provided further, That*".
