

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2187, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. KIRK OF ILLINOIS

In section 102(b)(1) of the bill, after “subsection (a)” insert “or paragraph (5)”.

In section 102(b) of the bill, add at the end the following:

1 (5) DISCRETIONARY GRANT PROGRAM.—From
2 the amount appropriated to carry out this title for
3 each fiscal year pursuant to section 311(a), the Sec-
4 retary shall reserve 1 percent of such amount for the
5 discretionary grant program under section 309(c).

In section 309 of the bill, redesignate subsection (c) as subsection (d).

In section 309 of the bill, insert after subsection (b) the following:

6 (c) DISCRETIONARY GRANT PROGRAM.—
7 (1) IN GENERAL.—From the amount reserved
8 under section 102(b)(5), the Secretary may make
9 grants of up to \$10,000 per project to local edu-
10 cational agencies for public school modernization,

1 renovation, repair, or construction projects that sat-
2 isfy the requirement of subsection (a).

3 (2) APPLICATION.—A local educational agency
4 desiring to receive a grant under paragraph (1) shall
5 submit an application at such time, in such manner,
6 and containing such information as the Secretary
7 may reasonably require.

8 (3) MATCHING FUNDS.—A grant shall be made
9 for a project under paragraph (1) only if at least 50
10 percent of the costs of the project will be paid from
11 non-Federal sources.

12 (4) APPLICABLE PERCENTAGE.—Funds re-
13 ceived or expended under this subsection shall not be
14 counted for purposes of determining compliance with
15 subsection (a).
