EN BLOC AMENDMENTS TO H.R. 2200**OFFERED BY** Mr. Mica

In section 401—

(1) in the matter preceding paragraph (1), insert “and the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure” after “Committee on Homeland Security”;

(2) in paragraph (2), strike “duplicate” and all that follows through the end of the paragraph and insert “conflict with Federal programs;”; and

(3) strike paragraph (3) and insert the following:

1 (3) a determination as to whether such back-
2 ground checks and forms of identification assist
3 State and local governments in carrying out the
4 safety, security, and law enforcement responsibilities
5 of those governments; and

6 (4) recommendations on methods, procedures,
7 and regulations that will—

8 (A) minimize redundant background
9 checks and forms of identification required for
10 access to port facilities; and

1 (B) facilitate the sharing of background
2 check and identification data with State and
3 local governments when the sharing of such
4 data assists those governments in carrying out
5 their safety, security, and law enforcement re-
6 sponsibilities.

 In section 432, in the quoted section 2107, add at
the end the following new subsection:

7 “(d) LIMITATION WITH RESPECT TO VESSEL AND
8 FACILITY SECURITY PLANS.—Notwithstanding subsection
9 (a), the Secretary shall not prohibit a State or political
10 subdivision thereof from requiring a separate background
11 check for entry into any area covered by a vessel or facility
12 security plan required under subsection 70103(c) of title
13 46, United States Code.
