

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2410, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MRS. DAVIS OF CALIFORNIA**

At the end of subtitle A of title XI, add the following:

1 **SEC. 11 ____ . AUDIT REQUIREMENTS FOR THE INSPECTORS**
2 **GENERAL OF THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE,**
3 **THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE, AND THE**
4 **UNITED STATES AGENCY FOR INTER-**
5 **NATIONAL DEVELOPMENT, AND THE SPECIAL**
6 **INSPECTOR GENERAL FOR AFGHANISTAN RE-**
7 **CONSTRUCTION.**

8 (a) **AUDIT REQUIREMENTS.**—The Inspectors General
9 of the Department of State, the Department of Defense,
10 and the United States Agency for International Develop-
11 ment, and the Special Inspector General for Afghanistan
12 Reconstruction should address, as appropriate, in their au-
13 diting and assessment protocols for Afghanistan, the im-
14 pact United States development assistance has on the so-
15 cial, economic, and political empowerment of Afghan
16 women, including the extent to which such assistance
17 helps to carry out the following:

18 (1) Section 103(a)(7) of the Afghan Freedom
19 Support Act (Public Law 107-327).

1 (2) The goal expressed in section 102(4) of the
2 Afghan Freedom Support Act (Public Law 107-327)
3 to “help achieve a broad-based, multi-ethnic, gender-
4 sensitive, and fully representative government in Af-
5 ghanistan that is freely chosen by the people of Af-
6 ghanistan and that respects the human rights of all
7 Afghans, particularly women.”.

8 (b) REPORT.—Not later than one year after the date
9 of the enactment of this Act, the Inspectors General of
10 the Department of State, the Department of Defense, and
11 the United States Agency for International Development,
12 and the Special Inspector General for Afghanistan Recon-
13 struction shall submit to Congress a report on the imple-
14 mentation of this section.
