

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2410, AS REPORTED**  
**OFFERED BY MR. FRANKS OF ARIZONA**

Page 145, after line 2, insert the following new paragraph:

1           (4) REPORT.—The Ambassador, in consultation  
2           with the Administrator of the United States Agency  
3           for International Development and the heads of  
4           other relevant United States Government depart-  
5           ments and agencies, shall submit to the appropriate  
6           congressional committee an annual report that, with  
7           respect to each foreign country that received United  
8           States assistance during the preceding year, de-  
9           scribes—

10                   (A) the male-female birth ratios in the  
11                   country for the current year and preceding 10  
12                   years;

13                   (B) an investigative, comprehensive survey  
14                   of scholarly literature and official documenta-  
15                   tion of the country demonstrating the practice  
16                   of sex-selection abortion in the country, in addi-  
17                   tion to any information in the possession of the  
18                   Department of State demonstrating an estab-

1 lished practice of sex-selection abortion in the  
2 country for the preceding 10 years;

3 (C) any evidence in the possession of the  
4 Department of State demonstrating that United  
5 States assistance is or has been provided to en-  
6 tities that practice or finance sex-selection abor-  
7 tion at any point in the preceding 10 years;

8 (D) an annual update of the laws or poli-  
9 cies in place in the country to prohibit or com-  
10 bat the practice of sex-selection abortion;

11 (E) precautionary measures taken by the  
12 Department of State, the United States Agency  
13 for International Development, and other rel-  
14 evant United States Government departments  
15 and agencies to ensure, in each country with a  
16 demonstrated history of sex-selection abortion,  
17 that United States assistance provided for  
18 healthcare or other purposes does not fund sex-  
19 selection abortions;

20 (F) an accounting of all abortions per-  
21 formed in the country;

22 (G) an accounting of all abortions per-  
23 formed or financed with United States assist-  
24 ance in the country; and

1           (H) an accounting in the form of an esti-  
2           mate of all sex-selection abortions (“missing  
3           girls”) within each country receiving United  
4           States family planning funds based on the  
5           male-female birth ratios described in subpara-  
6           graph (A).
