

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2410, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. JACKSON OF ILLINOIS**

In section 313, strike "The first sentence" and insert the following:

1 (a) IN GENERAL.—The first sentence

In section 313, add at the end the following:

2 (b) ADDITIONAL AMOUNT.—Section 413 of the For-
3 eign Service Act of 1980 (22 U.S.C. 3973) is amended—

4 (1) by redesignating subsection (d) as sub-
5 section (e); and

6 (2) by inserting after subsection (c) the fol-
7 lowing new subsection:

8 "(d) In addition to a death gratuity payment under
9 subsection (a), the Secretary or the head of the relevant
10 United States Government agency is authorized to provide
11 for payment to the surviving dependents of a Foreign
12 Service employee or a Government executive branch em-
13 ployee, if such Foreign Service employee or Government
14 executive branch employee is subject to the authority of
15 the chief of mission pursuant to section 207, of an amount
16 equal to a maximum of eight times the salary of such For-
17 eign Service employee or Government executive branch

1 employee if such Foreign Service employee or Government
2 executive branch employee is killed as a result of an act
3 of international terrorism. Such payment shall be accorded
4 the same treatment as a payment made under subsection
5 (a). For purposes of this subsection, the term ‘act of inter-
6 national terrorism’ has the meaning given such term in
7 section 2331(1) of title 18, United States Code.”.

8 (c) PAYMENTS TO FAMILIES OF CERTAIN VICTIMS OF
9 TERRORISM.—Subject to the availability of appropriations
10 specifically for the purpose specified in this section as pro-
11 vided in appropriations Acts enacted on or after October
12 1, 2007, and notwithstanding any other provision of law,
13 the Secretary of State shall pay the maximum amount of
14 payment under section 413(d) of the Foreign Service Act
15 of 1980 (as amended by subsection (b) of this section)
16 to an individual described in such section 413(d) or to an
17 individual who was otherwise serving at a United States
18 diplomatic or consular mission abroad without a regular
19 salary who was killed as a result of an act of international
20 terrorism (as such term is defined in section 2331(1) of
21 title 18, United States Code) that occurred between Janu-
22 ary 1, 1998, and the date of the enactment of this Act,
23 including the victims of the bombing of August 7, 1998,
24 in Nairobi, Kenya. Such a payment shall be deemed to
25 be a payment under section 413(d) of the Foreign Service

1 Act of 1980, except that for purposes of this section, such
2 payment shall, with respect to a United States citizen re-
3 ceiving payment under this section, be in an amount equal
4 to ten times the salary specified in this section. For pur-
5 poses of this section and section 413(d) of such Act, with
6 respect to a United States citizen receiving payment under
7 this section, the salary to be used for purposes of deter-
8 mining such payment shall be \$94,000.
