

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2410, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. MCMAHON OF NEW YORK**

Page 171, beginning line 3, insert the following:

1 (e) PROVIDING EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE TO
2 PEACE CORPS VOLUNTEERS.—

3 (1) MEDICAL EDUCATION ASSISTANCE BENE-
4 FITS.—Section 5 of the Peace Corps Act (22 U.S.C.
5 2504) is amended by adding at the end the following
6 new subsection:

7 “(o) For each year of service, as defined under sec-
8 tion 26(e), a volunteer who is accepted for enrollment, or
9 enrolled, in a course of study or program at any accredited
10 public or nonprofit private hospital, school of medicine or
11 osteopathic medicine within the United States for the pur-
12 pose of undergraduate medical education shall be granted
13 tuition assistance for a maximum of two years. The Presi-
14 dent shall determine the amount of such assistance, to be
15 not less than 50 percent but not more than 100 percent
16 of the cost of such tuition incurred by such volunteer.”.

17 (2) USE OF FUNDS.—Section 15 of the Peace
18 Corps Act (22 U.S.C. 2514) is amended by adding
19 at the end the following new subsection:

1 “(e) Funds made available for the purposes of this
2 Act may be used for tuition assistance in accordance with
3 subsection (o) of section 5, if the volunteer described in
4 such subsection is accepted for enrollment, or remains en-
5 rolled full-time in a course of study or program described
6 in such subsection within three years of the completion
7 of service by such volunteer.”.
