

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2410, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MS. ROS-LEHTINEN OF FLORIDA

In title XI, add at the end of subtitle A the following and amend the table of contents accordingly:

1 **SEC. 1114. HOLOCAUST-ERA INSURANCE POLICIES.**

2 (a) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of Con-
3 gress that the Secretary of State should urge the govern-
4 ment of any country in which one ore more of its domestic
5 insurers have not adequately settled covered Holocaust-era
6 insurance policies or have not disclosed the names of the
7 owners of such policies to enact and implement necessary
8 legislation to resolve these issues with respect to such poli-
9 cies.

10 (b) STATEMENTS OF INTEREST.—No funds author-
11 ized to be appropriated under this Act may be used by
12 the Department of State for the purpose of preparing or
13 issuing any statement of interest, including by providing
14 assistance to, or coordinating with, any other department
15 or agency of the United States for the purpose of pre-
16 paring or issuing such statement of interest, to encourage
17 a court in the United States to dismiss any claim brought
18 against an insurer or related company to recover com-

1 pensation arising out of or related to a covered Holocaust-
2 era insurance policy.

3 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

4 (1) COVERED HOLOCAUST-ERA INSURANCE POL-
5 ICY.—

6 (A) IN GENERAL.—The term “covered
7 Holocaust-era insurance policy” means any life,
8 dowry, education, property, or other insurance
9 policy that—

10 (i) was in effect at any time after
11 January 30, 1933, and before December
12 31, 1945; and

13 (ii) was issued to a policyholder domi-
14 ciled in any area that was occupied or con-
15 trolled by Nazi Germany.

16 (B) NAZI GERMANY.—In this paragraph,
17 the term “Nazi Germany” means—

18 (i) the Nazi government of Germany;
19 and

20 (ii) any government in any area occu-
21 pied by the military forces of the Nazi gov-
22 ernment of Germany.

23 (2) INSURER.—The term “insurer” means—

24 (A) any person engaged in the business of
25 insurance (including reinsurance) in interstate

1 or foreign commerce, if the person issued a cov-
2 ered Holocaust-era insurance policy; or

3 (B) a successor in interest to a person de-
4 scribed in subparagraph (A).

5 (3) RELATED COMPANY.—The term “related
6 company” means an affiliate, as that term is defined
7 in section 104(g) of the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act
8 (15 U.S.C. 6701(g)).
