

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2454**  
**OFFERED BY MR. CHAFFETZ OF UTAH**

Page 296, after line 6, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 199. INFORMATION TO CONSUMERS.**

2       (a) EPA PUBLICATION.—In carrying out title VII of  
3 the Clean Air Act (as added by section 311 of this Act),  
4 the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agen-  
5 cy shall publish, on a monthly basis, the average cost per  
6 kilowatt hour of the emission allowances purchased by  
7 each person generating electricity for sale. In such publi-  
8 cation, the Administrator shall provide an allocation of  
9 such costs, based on the generation sources, among re-  
10 gions identified by the Administrator in which electric  
11 power is purchased and sold at wholesale. The Adminis-  
12 trator shall consult with the Federal Energy Regulatory  
13 Commission and the Secretary of Energy in carrying out  
14 this section.

15       (b) INFORMATION TO CONSUMERS.—Section 115(f)  
16 of the Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act of 1978 (16  
17 U.S.C. 2625(f)) is amended by adding at the end the fol-  
18 lowing new paragraph:

19               “(4) For purposes of the standard for informa-  
20       tion to consumers established by section 113(b)(3),

1 each electric utility shall include in each billing  
2 statement transmitted to each electric consumer a  
3 statement of the portion of the rate charged to that  
4 consumer that represents the cost of emission allow-  
5 ances purchased by the utility for the period covered  
6 by such billing statement. In the case of a utility  
7 purchasing electric energy in a region for which the  
8 Administrator of the Environmental Protection  
9 Agency has published the average cost per kilowatt  
10 hour of emission allowances associated with electric  
11 power sold in that region, the utility shall include  
12 the appropriate portion of such costs in each such  
13 billing statement. For purposes of adopting the  
14 standard under section 113(b)(3) as modified by this  
15 paragraph, the date 2 years after the date of the en-  
16 actment of this paragraph shall be substituted for  
17 the 2-year period specified in section 113(a).”
