

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2454**OFFERED BY MS. GIFFORDS OF ARIZONA**

Page 12, line 25, strike “electricity” and insert “energy”.

Page 13, after line 10, insert:

1 In the case of solar energy referred to in subparagraph
2 (B) of paragraph (19), for purposes of applying this para-
3 graph, 1,000,000 British Thermal Units (Btu.) derived
4 from the sun as described in such subparagraph shall be
5 considered equivalent to 293 kilowatt-hours (kWh) of elec-
6 tricity.

Page 23, after line 18, insert the following new
paragraph and redesignate the succeeding paragraphs ac-
cordingly:

7 (19) SOLAR ENERGY.—The term “solar energy”
8 means either of the following:

9 (A) Electricity derived from solar radiation
10 including electricity generated by photovoltaic
11 equipment and equipment that transforms solar
12 radiation into heat energy used to generate
13 electric power.

1 (B) Heat energy derived from the sun and
2 used to heat or cool air or water for use in a
3 structure, or to provide solar process heat, ex-
4 cepting property used to generate energy for
5 the purposes of heating a residential swimming
6 pool.
