

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2647, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. FRANKS OF ARIZONA**

At the end of subtitle C of title II (page 67, after line 5), insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. 227. AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS FOR MISSILE DEFENSE.**

2 (a) **FUNDING.**—The amount otherwise provided by
3 section 201(4) for research, development, test, and evalua-
4 tion, Defense-wide, is hereby increased by \$480,000,000,
5 for the purposes of the continued testing, fielding,
6 sustainment, and modernization of the ground-based mid-
7 course defense system, specifically—

8 (1) not less than 44 ground-based interceptors
9 at Fort Greely, Alaska and Vandenberg Air Force
10 Base, California;

11 (2) completion of missile field number two at
12 Fort Greely, Alaska;

13 (3) aging and surveillance;

14 (4) capability enhancement;

15 (5) modernization and obsolescence;

16 (6) operationally realistic testing; and

17 (7) viable production capability.

18 (b) **OFFSETTING REDUCTION.**—The amount other-
19 wise provided by section 3101(2) for defense nuclear non-

1 proliferation activities is hereby reduced by \$480,000,000,
2 of which—

3 (1) \$179,000,000 is to be derived from inter-
4 national materials protection and cooperation;

5 (2) \$221,000,000 is to be derived from the
6 global threat reduction initiative; and

7 (3) \$80,000,000 is to be derived from the
8 amount for the verification, disablement, and dis-
9 mantlement of the nuclear program of North Korea,
10 of which—

11 (A) \$40,000,000 is to be derived from non-
12 proliferation and international security; and

13 (B) \$40,000,000 is to be derived from the
14 global threat reduction initiative.
