

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2647, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. HALL OF NEW YORK

In section 551(a), relating to assistance to schools with significant numbers of military dependent students, strike “\$50,000.000” (page 144, line 15) and insert “\$60,000,000”.

In section 551, insert after subsection (b) (page 145, after line 2) the following new subsection (c) (and redesignate existing subsection (c) as subsection (d)):

- 1 (c) ASSISTANCE TO LOCAL EDUCATIONAL AGENCIES
2 CONTAINING MILITARY SERVICE ACADEMIES.—
3 (1) AVAILABILITY OF ASSISTANCE.—Of the
4 amount authorized to be appropriated for fiscal year
5 2010 pursuant to section 301(5) for operation and
6 maintenance for Defense-wide activities, \$2,000,000
7 shall be available only for the purpose of providing
8 assistance under section 572(a) of the National De-
9 fense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2006 (Pub-
10 lic Law 109–163; 119 Stat. 3271; 20 U.S.C. 7703b)
11 to local educational agencies whose jurisdiction con-
12 tains—

1 (A) all or a portion of the campus of the
2 United States Military Academy, the United
3 States Naval Academy, or the United States
4 Air Force Academy; and

5 (B) at least 60 percent federally owned
6 real property, as certified by the local tax asses-
7 sor.

8 (2) SPECIAL RULE.—Paragraph (2) of section
9 572(a) of the National Defense Authorization Act
10 for Fiscal Year 2006 shall not apply to a local edu-
11 cational agency described in paragraph (1).
