

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2647, AS REPORTED**  
**OFFERED BY MR. KLEIN OF FLORIDA**

At the end of subtitle C of title V (page 134, after line 24), add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 524. REPORT ON PRESENCE OF MEMBERS OF EXTREM-**  
2 **IST GROUPS IN THE ARMED FORCES.**

3 (a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds the following:

4 (1) The United States military maintains a  
5 high state of readiness and attracts and trains high-  
6 quality men and women.

7 (2) Department of Defense Directive 1325.6,  
8 “Guidelines for Handling Dissident and Protest Ac-  
9 tivities Among Members of the Armed Forces”,  
10 states that military personnel must reject participa-  
11 tion in organizations that: Espouse supremacist  
12 causes; attempt to create illegal discrimination based  
13 on race, creed, color, sex, religion or nation origin;  
14 or advocate the use of force or violence, or otherwise  
15 engage in efforts to deprive individuals of their civil  
16 rights.

17 (3) Army Command Policy states that military  
18 personnel must reject participation in extremist or-  
19 ganizations and activities, defining extremist organi-

1 zations and activities as ones that advocate racial,  
2 gender or ethnic hatred or intolerance; advocate, cre-  
3 ate, or engage in illegal discrimination based on  
4 race, color, gender, religion, or national origin or ad-  
5 vocate the use of or use force or violence or unlawful  
6 means to deprive individuals of their rights under  
7 the United States Constitution or the laws of the  
8 United States, or any State, by unlawful means.

9 (4) Recent media reports indicate that extrem-  
10 ist groups are encouraging their members to join the  
11 United States military and use their military train-  
12 ing to train members of extremist groups.

13 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 120 days after the date  
14 of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense shall  
15 submit to Congress a report describing—

16 (1) the current efforts of the Armed Forces to  
17 enforce Department of Defense Directive 1325.6 en-  
18 titled “Guidelines for Handling Dissident and Pro-  
19 test Activities Among Members of the Armed  
20 Forces”, to ensure that members of the Armed  
21 Forces are not participating in extremist groups;

22 (2) the current efforts of the Armed Forces to  
23 prevent the recruitment of persons for enlistment in  
24 the Armed Forces when those persons have ties to  
25 extremist groups;

1           (3) the current efforts of the Armed Forces to  
2           train military recruiters to identify signs of a pos-  
3           sible recruit's ties to extremist groups; and

4           (4) the damage caused to United States na-  
5           tional security and military readiness by members of  
6           extremist groups who are also members of the  
7           Armed Forces.
