

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2647, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY Ms. SCHAKOWSKY OF ILLINOIS**

At the end of title VIII (page 291, after line 2), add
the following new section:

1 **SEC. 830. RESTRICTIONS ON USE OF PRIVATE SECURITY**
2 **CONTRACTORS BEYOND PERIMETER OF MILI-**
3 **TARY OR GOVERNMENT INSTALLATION.**

4 (a) **RESTRICTION.**—Except as provided in subsection
5 (b), in an area of combat operations, the Secretary of De-
6 fense may not use a covered contract for the performance
7 of private security functions beyond the secure perimeter
8 of a military or United States Government installation.

9 (b) **EXCEPTIONS.**—Subsection (a) does not apply—
10 (1) in the case of a covered contract for the
11 performance of private security functions if the func-
12 tions are to be performed by host country nationals;
13 or

14 (2) in any case with respect to which the Presi-
15 dent determines it is necessary to waive the applica-
16 bility of subsection (a) in the interests of national
17 security.

18 (c) **DEFINITIONS.**—In this section:

1 (1) COVERED CONTRACT.—In this section, the
2 term “covered contract” means—

3 (A) a contract of the Department of De-
4 fense for the performance of private security
5 functions in an area of combat operations;

6 (B) a subcontract at any tier under such
7 a contract; or

8 (C) a task order or delivery order issued
9 under such a contract or subcontract.

10 (2) AREA OF COMBAT OPERATIONS.—The term
11 “area of combat operations” means an area of com-
12 bat operations as designated by the Secretary of De-
13 fense under subsection (c) of section 862 of the Na-
14 tional Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year
15 2008 (Public Law 110–181; 10 U.S.C. 2302 note).

16 (3) PRIVATE SECURITY FUNCTIONS.—The term
17 “private security functions” means activities en-
18 gaged in by a contractor under a covered contract as
19 follows:

20 (A) Guarding of personnel, facilities, or
21 property of a Federal agency, the contractor or
22 subcontractor, or a third party.

23 (B) Any other activity for which personnel
24 are required to carry weapons in the perform-
25 ance of their duties.

1 (d) EFFECT ON HUMANITARIAN MISSIONS.—Nothing
2 in this section may be construed as prohibiting the use
3 of covered contracts for the performance of private secu-
4 rity functions for humanitarian missions of the Depart-
5 ment of Defense.

6 (e) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This section shall take effect
7 six months after the date of the enactment of this Act.
