

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2647, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. STUPAK OF MICHIGAN**

Page 94, after line 2, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 316. NOTIFICATION OF CERTAIN RESIDENTS AND CI-**
2 **VILIAN EMPLOYEES AT CAMP LEJEUNE,**
3 **NORTH CAROLINA, OF EXPOSURE TO DRINK-**
4 **ING WATER CONTAMINATION.**

5 (a) NOTICE TO MEMBERS OF CONGRESS.—Not later
6 than one year after the date of the enactment of this Act,
7 the Secretary of the Navy shall submit to each Member
8 of Congress notification that shall include—

9 (1) information on the individuals described in
10 subsection (b) who are resident of that Member's
11 congressional district, aggregated by county; and

12 (2) such other information as the Secretary of
13 the Navy determines is appropriate.

14 (b) INDIVIDUALS DESCRIBED.—Individuals described
15 in this subsection are the following:

16 (1) Individuals who were served by the Tarawa
17 Terrace Water Distribution System, including Knox
18 Trailer Park, at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina.

19 (2) Individuals who were served by the Hadnot
20 Point water distribution system during the period

1 identified in the water modeling study of the system
2 conducted by the Agency for Toxic Substances and
3 Disease Registry (hereinafter referred to in this sec-
4 tion as the "ATSDR").

5 (3) Civilian employees who worked at Camp
6 Lejeune during the period identified in the ATSDR
7 water modeling study.

8 (c) INFORMATION SHARING.—

9 (1) FINDINGS.—Congress makes the following
10 findings:

11 (A) The Secretary of the Navy and Com-
12 mandant of the Marine Corps are responsible
13 for the identification and timely sharing of all
14 relevant documents relating to the Camp
15 Lejeune base-wide drinking-water systems, in-
16 cluding all documents of which the ATSDR
17 may not be aware and all documents that are
18 in the possession of the Department of Defense,
19 and all contractors, sub-contractors, and con-
20 sultants of the Department but may no longer
21 be located at the Camp Lejeune base.

22 (B) Discovery of this documentation must
23 not rely on specific requests from the ATSDR
24 but on a shared goal of ensuring the scientific
25 accuracy of the current health study and the re-

1 sponsibility of the Secretary of Defense to pro-
2 vide such information.

3 (2) REQUIREMENT.—The Secretary of Defense,
4 the Secretary of the Navy, and the Commandant of
5 the Marine Corps shall immediately provide to the
6 ATSDR a catalogue of all electronic databases of
7 the Department of Defense that may contain infor-
8 mation on the Camp Lejeune drinking-water sys-
9 tems, its historical and present-day operations, and
10 its operational records, together with access to such
11 databases.
