**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2701, AS REPORTED**

**OFFERED BY Mr. Hoekstra**

At the end of subtitle A of title V, add the following  
new section:

1 **SEC. 505. PANEL ON INTELLIGENCE RELATING TO WEAP-**  
2 **ONS OF MASS DESTRUCTION PROGRAMS OF**  
3 **IRAN.**

4 (a) **ESTABLISHMENT.**—The Director of National In-  
5 telligence shall establish a panel to review intelligence re-  
6 lating to weapons of mass destruction programs of Iran.

7 (b) **MEMBERS.**—

8 (1) **IN GENERAL.**—The panel established under  
9 subsection (a) shall consist of seven members, who  
10 shall be appointed by the Director of National Intel-  
11 ligence.

12 (2) **QUALIFICATIONS.**—Members appointed  
13 under paragraph (1) shall—

14 (A) not be personnel of the intelligence  
15 community (as defined in section 3(4) of the  
16 National Security Act of 1947 (50 U.S.C.  
17 401a(4)));

18 (B) have experience and expertise in issues  
19 of national security; and

1 (C) as a whole, have balanced views and  
2 experience.

3 (e) ACCESS TO INFORMATION.—The Director of Na-  
4 tional Intelligence shall, to the greatest extent possible,  
5 provide the panel with access to all intelligence informa-  
6 tion necessary for the panel to assess weapons of mass  
7 destruction programs of Iran.

8 (d) REPORT.—Not later than July 31, 2010, the  
9 panel established under subsection (a) shall submit to  
10 Congress and the Director of National Intelligence a re-  
11 port containing an assessment of intelligence relating to  
12 weapons of mass destruction programs of Iran.

13 (e) TERMINATION.—The panel established under sub-  
14 section (a) shall terminate on the date that is 30 days  
15 after the date on which the report required under sub-  
16 section (c) is submitted.
