

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2701, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MS. MOORE OF WISCONSIN**

At the end of subtitle A of title IV, add the following
new section:

1 **SEC. 407. NATIONAL INTELLIGENCE CENTER ON SCREEN-**
2 **ING OF AIRLINE PASSENGERS.**

3 (a) ESTABLISHMENT.—Title I of the National Secu-
4 rity Act of 1947 (50 U.S.C. 401 et seq.) is amended by
5 adding at the end the following new section:

6 “NATIONAL INTELLIGENCE CENTER RELATING TO THE
7 SCREENING OF AIRLINE PASSENGERS

8 “SEC. 120. (a) ESTABLISHMENT.—The Director of
9 National Intelligence shall establish a national intelligence
10 center in accordance with section 119B to review intel-
11 ligence related to foreign countries that are state sponsors
12 of terrorism or other countries of interest, as identified
13 in security directives issued by the Transportation Secu-
14 rity Administration on January 3, 2010, relating to en-
15 hanced aviation passenger screening (or any successor to
16 those security directives).

17 “(b) REPORTS.—The head of the center established
18 in accordance with subsection (a) shall biannually submit
19 to the President and the Secretary of Homeland Security

1 recommendations based on intelligence analysis and as-
2 sessment as to whether—

3 “(1) a foreign country that is not currently
4 identified in the security directives referred to in
5 subsection (a) should be so identified; or

6 “(2) a foreign country currently identified in
7 such security directives should not be so identified.”.

8 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—The table of con-
9 tents in the first section of such Act (50 U.S.C. 401 note)
10 is further amended by inserting after the item relating to
11 section 119B the following new item:

“Sec. 120. National intelligence center relating to the screening of airline pas-
sengers.”.
