

**AMENDMENT TO MR. RAHALL'S AMENDMENT TO
H.R. 3534, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. HINCHEY OF NEW YORK**

At the appropriate point in the bill, add the following new section:

**ONLINE AVAILABILITY TO THE PUBLIC OF INFORMATION RELATING TO OIL
AND GAS CHEMICAL USE.**

(a) **IN GENERAL.**—An operator authorized to explore for, develop, or produce oil and gas under any Federal mineral leasing law shall:

1. 15 days prior to drilling a well on a lease area or any portion thereof, make the list of chemicals intended for use in drilling or completing the well, including the chemical constituents of mixtures, Chemical Abstracts Service numbers, and material safety data sheets, available to the public on an Internet website created and maintained by the Bureau of Safety and Environmental Enforcement, and;
2. within 30 days after completion of drilling a well on a lease area or any portion thereof, make the list of chemicals used in drilling or completing the well, including the chemical constituents of mixtures, Chemical Abstracts Service numbers, and material safety data sheets, available to the public on an Internet website created and maintained by the Bureau of Safety and Environmental Enforcement.

(b) **PROPRIETARY CHEMICAL FORMULAS.**—This section does not authorize the Director of the Bureau of Safety and Environmental Enforcement to require the public disclosure of proprietary chemical formula.

(c) **RULEMAKING AUTHORITY.**—Not later than 1 year after the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary, after providing notice and an opportunity for public comment, shall promulgate regulations to implement this section.
