

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 3619
OFFERED BY MR. PETERS OF MICHIGAN

Page 38, before line 7, insert the following new sub-section:

1 (d) REPORT.—Within 12 months after the date of en-
2 actment of this Act, the Comptroller General of the United
3 States shall report to Congress on the Coast Guard's ef-
4 forts to recruit minority candidates to the Coast Guard
5 Academy. The report shall include the following:

6 (1) The status of implementation of the Coast
7 Guard's minority recruitment program.

8 (2) An assessment of the effectiveness of the
9 program, including the number of minority appli-
10 cants contacted by the Coast Guard Academy, the
11 number of minority candidates who completed appli-
12 cations to the Academy, the number of minority can-
13 didates offered appointments to the Academy, and
14 the number of candidates who accepted such ap-
15 pointments.

16 (3) A comparison of the Coast Guard's minority
17 recruitment program with similar programs at other
18 United States service academies.

1 (4) Recommendations for enhancing the Coast
2 Guard's minority recruitment program.

3 (5) An assessment of the current geographic di-
4 versity of cadets currently enrolled at the Coast
5 Guard Academy including information on the num-
6 ber of candidates from each State and region of the
7 United States who were contacted by the Academy,
8 the number of candidates from each State and re-
9 gion of the United States who completed applica-
10 tions to the Academy, the number of candidates
11 from each State and region of the country offered
12 appointments to the Academy, and the number of
13 candidates from each State and region of the coun-
14 try who accepted such appointments.

15 (6) Recommendations for increasing the geo-
16 graphic diversity of the student population at the
17 Coast Guard Academy.
