

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4061, AS REPORTED

OFFERED BY REP. CLARKE

At the end of the bill, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 205. FEDERAL WORKFORCE COORDINATION.**

2 (a) **REQUIREMENTS.**—Within 180 days after the date
3 of enactment of this Act, the President, acting through
4 the Office of Science and Technology Policy and the White
5 House Cybersecurity Coordinator, and in coordination
6 with appropriate Federal agencies, shall create a search-
7 able, secure, dynamic technological platform of all Federal
8 cybersecurity functions, for the purposes of enhancing
9 interagency coordination for Federal cybersecurity.

10 (b) **FEDERAL CYBERSECURITY FUNCTIONS.**—For
11 purposes of this section, the term “Federal cybersecurity
12 functions” means all missions or services of the United
13 States Government related to fostering the confidentiality,
14 integrity, or availability of information technology net-
15 works. This includes—

16 (1) technological security functions, such as
17 research and development, design, procurement,
18 administration, securing, or reconstitution of Fed-
19 eral information technology networks or to meas-

1 uring or supporting the performance of those mis-
2 sions;

3 (2) missions and services that contribute to the
4 security of both Federal and global information com-
5 munications networks, such as cybersecurity-related
6 law enforcement, intelligence, information oper-
7 ations, and technological research, development, and
8 support; and

9 (3) development and enforcement of Federal
10 cybersecurity-related standards, law, policy, and
11 training, both domestic and international, and the
12 measurement and analysis of significant cybersecu-
13 rity incidents and relevant educational, labor, and
14 commercial data.

15 (c) DEVELOPING AND EXPANDING THE PLAT-
16 FORM.—The President shall survey and identify each
17 agency’s cybersecurity functions, and develop a capability
18 to ensure that these functions can be dynamically updated
19 and expanded. The President may also expand the plat-
20 form to include, as appropriate, cyber officials from State
21 and local governments, the private sector, and foreign gov-
22 ernments.

23 (d) PROMOTING THE USE OF THE PLATFORM.—The
24 President shall create and publicize incentives, rewards,
25 and disciplines for Federal personnel and agency heads to

1 use the platform. The President shall measure each agen-
2 cy's use of the platform and assess the ways in which the
3 platform is succeeding or failing at achieving greater inter-
4 agency collaboration.

5 (e) REPORT.—Within 1 year after the date of enact-
6 ment of this Act, the President shall issue a report to the
7 Congress describing the implementation of this section.
