

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4173**  
**OFFERED BY MR. CROWLEY OF NEW YORK**

Page 461, after line 19, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 1802. TEMPORARY INCREASE IN GUARANTEED LEND-**  
2 **ING AUTHORITY BY THE SMALL BUSINESS**  
3 **ADMINISTRATION.**

4 (a) INCREASE.—Section 20 of the Small Business Act  
5 (15 U.S.C. 631 note) is amended by inserting after sub-  
6 section (e) the following new subsection:

7 “(f) FISCAL YEARS 2010 AND 2011 WITH RESPECT  
8 TO SECTION 7(A).—

9 “(1) PROGRAM LEVELS.—In each of fiscal years  
10 2010 and 2011 commitments for general business  
11 loans authorized under section 7(a) are increased by  
12 \$20,000,000,000.

13 “(2) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—  
14 From amounts provided pursuant to section 115 of  
15 the Emergency Economic Stabilization Act of 2008  
16 (12 U.S.C. 5225; Public Law 110-343) there is au-  
17 thorized to be appropriated \$20,000,000 for each of  
18 fiscal years 2010 and 2011 to carry out paragraph  
19 (1).”.

1 (b) EXTENSION OF SBA FEE REDUCTIONS AND  
2 ELIMINATIONS.—Section 501(a) of the American Recov-  
3 ery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Public Law 111-5; 123  
4 Stat. 151) is amended by striking “September 30, 2010”  
5 and inserting “September 30, 1011”.

6 (c) EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY OF SBA GUAR-  
7 ANTEE.—Section 502(f) of the American Recovery and  
8 Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Public Law 111-5; 123 Stat.  
9 152) is amended by striking “the date 12 months after  
10 the date of enactment of this Act” and inserting “Sep-  
11 tember 30, 2011”.

12 (d) ALLOWABLE USES OF FUNDS.—Amounts appro-  
13 priated pursuant to the authorization of appropriations  
14 under subsection (f) of section 20 of the Small Business  
15 Act (15 U.S.C. 631 note), as added by subsection (a), may  
16 be used to carry out sections 501 and 502 of the American  
17 Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Public Law 111-  
18 5).
